
School Advisory Council MEETING MINUTES

Report from Administration

5 October 2021

- Enrollment 436 students: 3 English 2 French Immersion in grade 7; 3 English and 3 French Immersion classes in grade 8&9 for a total of 17 homerooms
- Chris MacLellan accepted a position at Auburn late in August; John Mumford joined our staff the 2nd week of school welcome John ☺
- Different start than last year students move from class to class and we are able to offer more activities
 - We will continue to build on this as things open up
- EMP we have completed our first evacuation, lock down and hold and secure drills
- Stand Up Against Bullying Day (pink shirt day) was observed September 9th
- Picture Day took place September 23rd
- New Role: Andrea Thomas started here as a Child and Youth Care Practitioner (CYCP) under the Schools Plus umbrella
- Virtual Curriculum Event was shared with our school community on Sep 29th
- Observed Orange Shirt Day (Every Child Matters) on Sep 29th
- Terry Fox Walk took place on Oct 1st each grade level completed the Colby Loop
 - \$560 has been donated online to date
- School Sport and Extracurricular Activities available to all students with proof of vaccination; coaches and volunteers must be vaccinated as well
 - Put spectators on hold to reduce demands on coaches to check vaccination status and ID
- No Student Fees yet this year we will request fees as we need them
- Cafeteria will be open next Tuesday, October 12th
- SAC Grant I have enquired but do not yet know when we can expect to receive these funds (last year: \$5000 + \$1 per student = \$5436)
- Breakfast Program funding remain in place this year
 - Run by our Learning Centre and Best Buddies

Student Success Planning (SSP)

- Laser focus on grade 8 Mathematics achievement
- Data is submitted and reviewed every 3 weeks; revise our approaches based on that information (short-cycle planning)

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Teacher Learning

- Sep 4th: Staff spent the day focussing on Well-Being in school and Curriculum Renewal
- Sep 24th: Morning was spent continuing our focus on Curriculum Renewal; in the afternoon teachers reviewed adaptations and IPPs for current students

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
