It is strongly recommended that students have an agenda to write down their homework, extra curricular activities and due dates.




Communication

 - 3) Teacher Emails

It is recommended that you check your child's Google Classroom, and Power School information frequently.



Independence

Social changes

"Show me your friends and I'll show you your path."

Keeping a close tab on your child's friendships and a strict eye on your child's social media will help navigate some of the friendship changes and relationships that your child may face.

Having open and honest conversations about the WHY and HOW (not just WHO) of relationships with your child can also build trust and allow your child to have a safe place to discuss options with you.
